Dear Parents,

So, here we are, nearly at your child's final term at Horley Infant School. We can't believe how fast this year has gone!

The topic after half term is **Superheroes!** We have a lot planned for this half term, so please take note of the dates on the other side of the page.

On Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup>, we will be visiting **Hever Castle**. Please make sure your child comes to school with 2 small bottles of water, and spare uniform and shoes for when we are on the Water Maze! Unless you ordered a school prepared packed lunch before half term, please make sure they bring their own lunch for the trip. The children will need to carry their belongings with them during the day, so it is best that they keep everything in a rucksack, which is easier to carry.

Then on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup>, we will be taking part in **Superhero University** to generate enthusiasm and kick start our topic. There will be lots of fun activities for your child to join in with, which is made even better if they are dressed as a superhero. So, we really encourage all children to be superheroes for the day.

**Home Learning** this term is slightly different to the previous terms. We will still send out the spelling booklet and ask that you read for 5-10 minutes each day and use Numbots or Time Tables Rock Stars to improve their number and multiplication fluency but there will be no Arithmetic Booklet.
